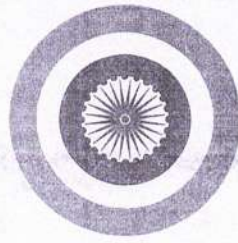

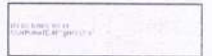

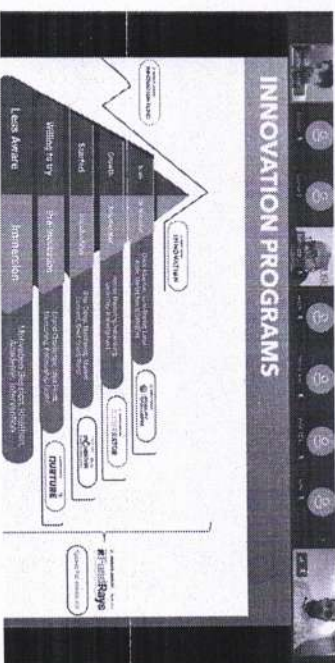

A special visit of industry leaders from Japan visited GUSEC to explore relevant startups. During the visit, 5 Startups have shown Pitch the innovative solutions.



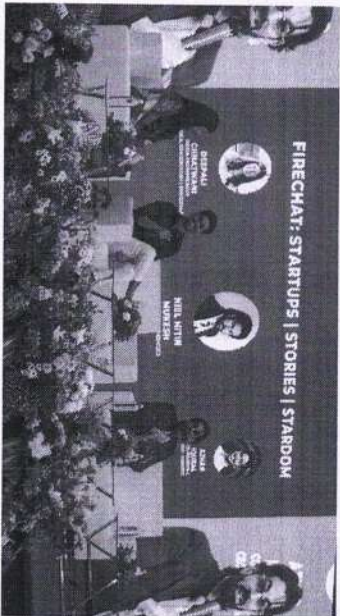

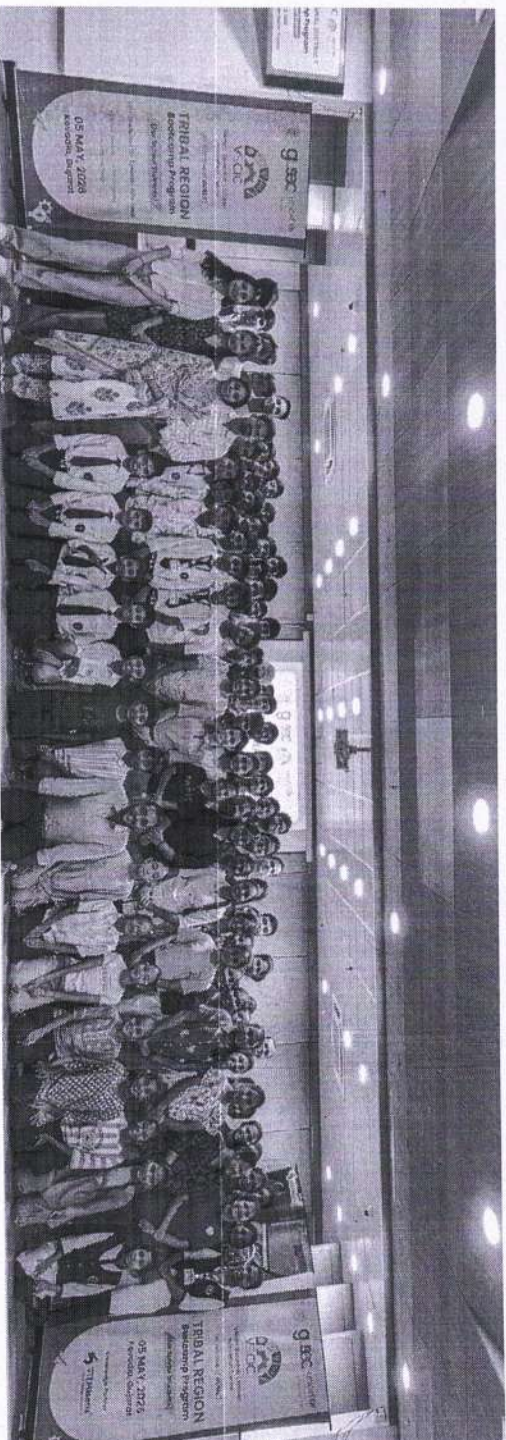
